Noa Schwartz Siris, MD, was initially diagnosed with osteosarcoma at age 12. She had a major recurrence at age 24, when she was a medical student, wife and mother of a 1 year old son. During the next five years she underwent numerous surgeries, courses of chemotherapy and intensive radiotherapy, while managing to complete medical school and internship. Her training as a physician led her consistently to seek the best treatment available, regardless of the attendant pain and suffering. Her strong religious faith, her courage and her humanity helped her to endure and to make the very most of her life. She inspired her doctors, her family and her fellow patients. She died of osteosarcoma at age 29.

- V. A final summary of the results of the study must be submitted to the Bone and Cancer Foundation within six months of completion of the study.
- VI. Acknowledgement of this grant must be included in all publications based on the study.
